GENERAL INFORMATION REGARDING USE OF OPTIONAL DNS PROCESS

When the SEPA field indicates a **Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS)** is expected, the optional DNS process is being used and a DNS is likely. This may be the only opportunity to comment on the environmental impacts of the proposal. The proposal may include mitigation measures under applicable codes and the project review process may incorporate or require mitigation measures regardless of whether an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is prepared. The Threshold Determination will also be noticed in a subsequent issue of this Weekly Permit Bulletin. A copy of the subsequent Threshold Determination for the proposal may be obtained upon request.

Description SEPA Threshold Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) to renew the City of Bellevue Utilities contract with private companies to haul the City's solid waste to King County transfer and landfill facilities and recyclables and organics to private processing facilities. This contract requires City Council approval and will go into effect on June 29, 2014. This contract was previously completed in 2004 and this new contract will maintain the curbside collection and hauling from single-family, multifamily, and commercial customers. The contract is required to implement the City's inter-local agreement with King County to process the City's waste under the King County Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan. **SEPA:** Determination of Non-Significance is issued.
