




Environmental & Public Outreach Process

Partnering with the Public

Between November 2005 and February 2009, the City of Bellevue hosted a series of open houses for the BelRed Corridor Project. Feedback was collected from the broader public on the vision for BelRed, and covered various aspects including land use, transportation and open space. The vision that was defined included an east – west arterial green street spanning the length of BelRed. This signature street is known as NE Spring Boulevard.

In November 2011, the City of Bellevue signed a memorandum of understanding (MOU) with Sound Transit for extending light rail through Bellevue. This voter-approved project is known as East Link. Although East Link is a Sound Transit project, Bellevue residents have offered input through citizen advisory committees, city council meetings, public meetings, workshops and open houses. East Link construction is expected to start in early 2016 and be operational in 2023.

The City of Bellevue and Sound Transit have partnered in a “collaborative design process” for both NE Spring Boulevard and East Link in an effort to reduce costs and ensure that the established policies and vision for BelRed are met.
